Eighteen years ago on this date he received a new set of lungs at Duke University Hospital. Leland was born with Cystic Fibrosis which destroyed his lungs and ability to breathe. He continues to be a walking miracle considering he was given seven years to live following the transplant. This week he will be speaking to a group of 100 plus doctors at Duke Medical. Leland has served Palm Beach County Youth for Christ for over 17 years. He runs a club similar to what we do with FCA in four different junior high schools. Here is story from one of the clubs that he sent out in his monthly newsletter. I just wanted to share it with you and celebrate Leland's life!

I met "Jay's" mom several weeks ago in the parking lot while she was picking him up from school. As I introduced myself and thanked her for letting her son attend Campus Life, she picked up on the fact that we talk about Jesus and her demeanor completely changed. She said, "Did he tell you that we are Jehovah's Witnesses?" I said, "No, but we appreciate you allowing him to come as we love everyone."

Have you ever felt like you just walked into a hornets' nest? As I walked away from that encounter, I sensed Jay was getting reamed out by his mom for attending our "Club." Surprisingly, he's come back to Campus Life since. But as I shared the True meaning of Easter several weeks back, I found it interesting that every time I said the word "Jesus" or "resurrection" Jay literally covered his ears with his hands. He sat quietly paying attention, but he was apparently not "allowed" to listen to Truth. Please pray that the Lord opens the ears of Jay's heart even though he closes the ears on his head.
